Other details of life in Port Phillip are being sought

They came by the 'Catherine Jamieson' as Self-funded and as Bounty Immigrants in 1841

The first trip by the "Catherine Jamieson" sailed, from Leith, had Messrs Allan and Son and Messrs Adamson and Co as the official agents. They left left Scotland from Kirkalldy Roads Leith, on 28 June 1838 and reached South Australia on 1 December 1838, after a journey of 5 months.

Catherine Jamieson

arrived 22 Oct 1841, barque 451 tons, Captain William Hutchinson master, from Leith (near Edinburgh) Scotland 29 May 1841 to Port Phillip. The importer was Mr Robert Howe of Sydney. Fiche 5 Page 137 almages 77-82, pages notes

Passengers Cabin - Messrs Gordon, Reid, Gow, Frazer, Irvine, Tate/Tait, and Porter who died of Jaundice during the voyage

Surgeon Superintendant John MacDonald reported 2 deaths and 3 births

Staff - John McDonald Super, William Hutchison Master, John Miller 1st Mate, John Wade 2nd Mate, Rob Ritchie 3rd Mate

No names for births, deaths, 2 males (maybe Christy Humphries and McLean) and 1 female (Catherine Jamieson King) born, one child died.

56 Adults can read and write, 26 can read only and 9 neither, total 91 souls. 152 Protestants 109 in 24 families - 24 males, 24 females, 3 males 15-18, Children 7-14, 13 males and 9 females, 1-7, 14m and 18f, under 1, 3m amd 1f

19 single males and 24 single females, total all souls 152 with Bounty of 2154 pounds.

The Agents received a 'Credit' of 5 females, to be offset when they next had a surplus of males, as with the Brilliant

The native place of the brothers John and James Barry was recorded as Co Tyrone and both could read and write. Another passenger is William Noble who returned to Ireland then brought his brother here in 1849

The Catherine Jamieson was later wrecked at Table Bay in 1860.
